AMENDMENT intended to be proposed by Mr. BLUNT (for  
himself and Mr. THUNE)

Viz:

1       At the end of subtitle A of title IV, add the following:

2   **SEC. \_\_\_\_ . POINT OF ORDER AGAINST LEGISLATION THAT**

3                   **WOULD CREATE A TAX OR FEE ON CARBON**

4                   **EMISSIONS.**

5       (a) POINT OF ORDER.—It shall not be in order in  
6 the Senate to consider any bill, joint resolution, motion,  
7 amendment, or conference report that—

8           (1) would result in revenues that would be

9       greater than the level of revenues set forth for the

10       first fiscal year or the total of that fiscal year and

1 the ensuing fiscal years under the concurrent resolu-  
2 tion on the budget then in effect for which alloca-  
3 tions are provided under section 302(a) of the Con-  
4 gressional Budget Act of 1974; and

5 (2) for any year covered by such resolution, in-  
6 cludes a Federal tax or fee imposed on carbon emis-  
7 sions from any product or entity that is a direct or  
8 indirect source of the emissions.

9 (b) WAIVER AND APPEAL.—

10 (1) WAIVER.—Subsection (a) may be waived or  
11 suspended in the Senate only by an affirmative vote  
12 of three-fifths of the Members, duly chosen and  
13 sworn.

14 (2) APPEAL.—An affirmative vote of three-  
15 fifths of the Members of the Senate, duly chosen and  
16 sworn, shall be required to sustain an appeal of the  
17 ruling of the Chair on a point of order raised under  
18 subsection (a).
