The devastating floods destroyed homes and businesses, badly damaged public infrastructure, and were responsible for the deaths of 15 people in the state. Now our communities are faced with the daunting task of rebuilding. The Federal assistance programs will help Missourians rebuild faster and leave our communities stronger and more prepared for future disasters. We ask you to act quickly to help us start the rebuilding process.


